

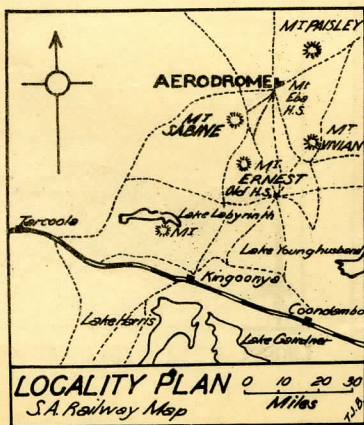
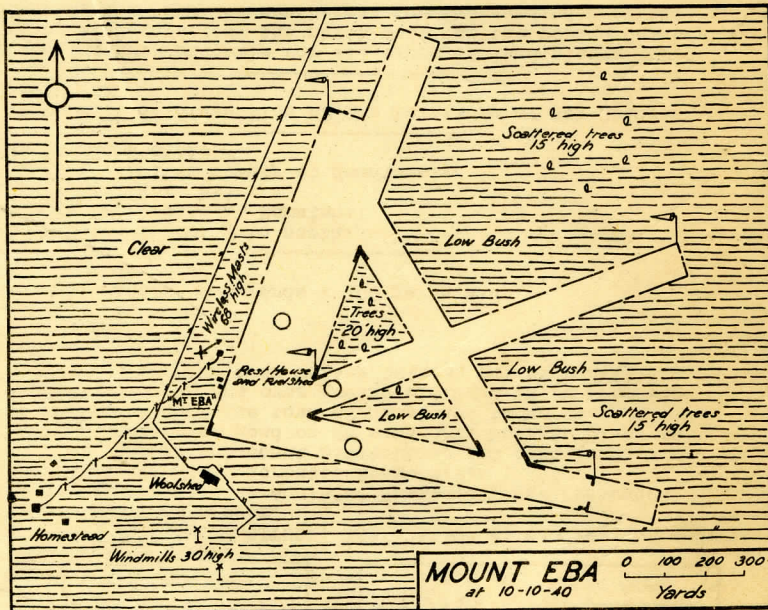

LATITUDE: 30° 11' S; LONGITUDE: 135° 41 E; MAG. VAR: 5° E. app.
ALTITUDE: 700 feet approx.
POSITION: Approx. 60 miles north of Kingoonya (Trans-Continental Railway).
RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.6.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat. Suitable for forced landings.
LANDMARKS: Homestead buildings and wireless masts near SW corner of aerodrome. Mt. Paisley (200 ft. high) approx. 8 miles to NE.
APPROACHES: Clear in all directions.
MARKINGS: Three circles (one in each runway) boundary marks and four wind indicators. "Mt. Eba" in white 10 ft. stone letters on SW corner, also "Eba" is painted on roof of Woolshed.
DIMENSIONS: Four landing strips as shown in sketch, each approx. 1,000 yards.
SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Kingoonya, 60 miles to south.
TELEPHONE: At Homestead.
HANGARS: Nil.
REPAIRS: Nil.
REFUELLING & WATER: At Homestead.
