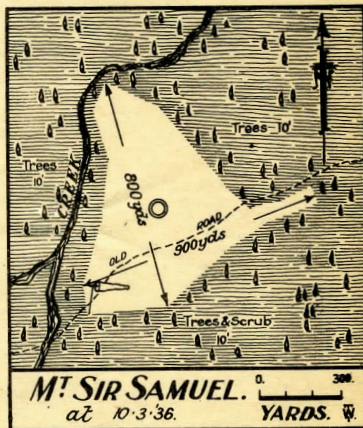
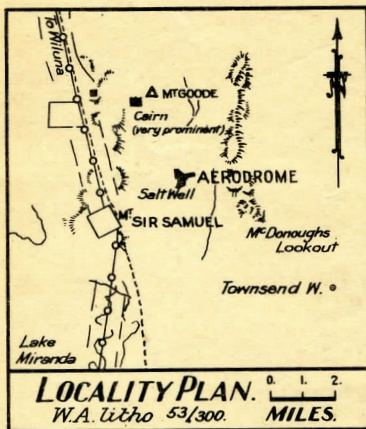


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

MT. SIR SAMUEL, W.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Leonora Road Board, Leonora, W.A.

POSITION: About $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles E.N.E. of township of Mt. Sir Samuel.

Lat. $27^{\circ} 36\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long. $120^{\circ} 35'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: About $\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West.

LANDMARKS: Smoke stack about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles to S.W.; Hotel at Mt.

Sir Samuel, about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles W.S.W.; dry lake 1 mile South.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE, ETC.: Level ironstone gravel and loam.

DIMENSIONS: N.N.W.-S.S.E. 800 yards; E.N.E.-W.S.W. 900 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 1,500 ft.

APPROACHES: Over scrub (10 feet high) on all sides.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Low hills covered with light scrub, rocky and rough.

PETROL AND OIL: At hotel, Mt. Sir Samuel, about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles W.S.W.

WATER SUPPLY: At hotel.

WORKSHOPS: Wiluna, about 80 miles North.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: At hotel, Mt. Sir Samuel.

NEAREST TOWN: Mt. Sir Samuel.

RAILWAY STATION: Wiluna, about 80 miles North.

CHARGES: 2/6 per landing, 10/- per day.

REMARKS: Surface may be soft after rain.
