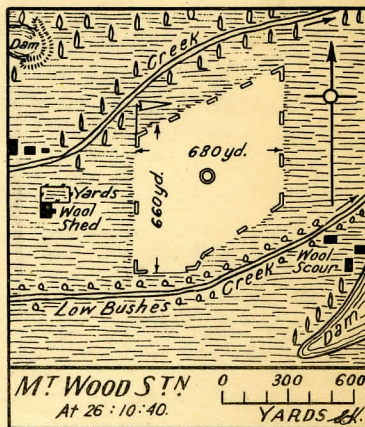
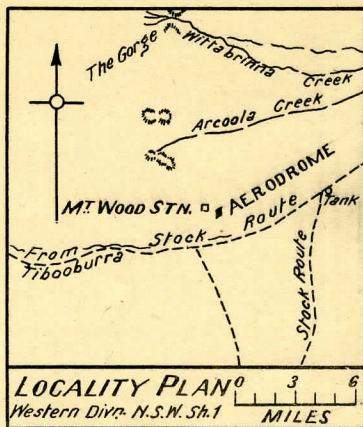

LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: $29^{\circ}27\frac{1}{2}'$ S. LONGITUDE: $142^{\circ}16'$ E. MAG. VAR: $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. app.

ALTITUDE: 350 feet approx.

POSITION: 14 miles ESE of Tibooburra township; $\frac{1}{2}$ mile SE of Mt. Wood Station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.8.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Level stony downs. Range of hills about 2 miles west.

LANDMARKS: Woolshed to west, woolscour SE. The name "Mt. Wood", with arrow pointing towards aerodrome, is painted on roof of woolshed.

APPROACHES: North - over 30 ft. trees along creek; south - over low bushes and scattered 25 ft. trees; east - clear; west - clear except for woolshed.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 660 yards; E-W, 680 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: Tibooburra, 18 miles WNW by road.

RAILWAY STATION: Broken Hill, 180 miles SW.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Facilities for minor repairs at homestead.

REFUELLING: Limited supply at station.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Mt. Wood Pastoral Company (Mr. J.A. Dorward, Manager), Tibooburra, via Broken Hill.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Surface is liable to become slippery after rain.
