

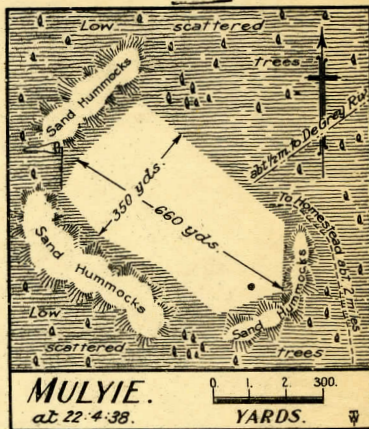
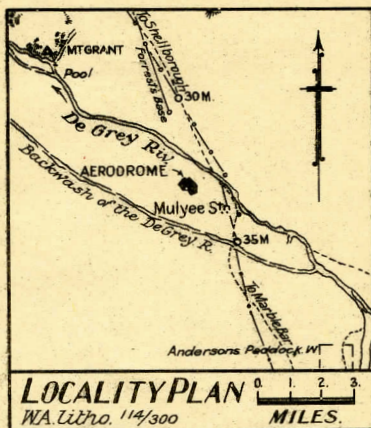

LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: 20° 27' S; LONGITUDE: 119° 29' E; MAG. VAR: 1° E. app.

ALTITUDE: 275 feet approx.

POSITION: About 2 miles NW of Mulyie Homestead and ½ mile south of De Grey River.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet F.4. Stripmap No.55.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally flat, with low timber and spinifex.

LANDMARKS: De Grey River ½ mile to north; backwater of river to south (both dry in dry season).

APPROACHES: Heavy timber along De Grey River and backwater, with low scattered trees and sand hummocks around ground.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 660 yds. NE-SW, 350 yds.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: Port Hedland, about 45 miles west.

RAILWAY STATION: Warralong Siding, about 30 miles SSW.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Blacksmith's shop at homestead.

REFUELLING: Limited supply at homestead.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETORS: De Grey River Pastoral Company, Mulyie Homestead, via Port Hedland, W.A.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Ground may be boggy in parts during wet season.
