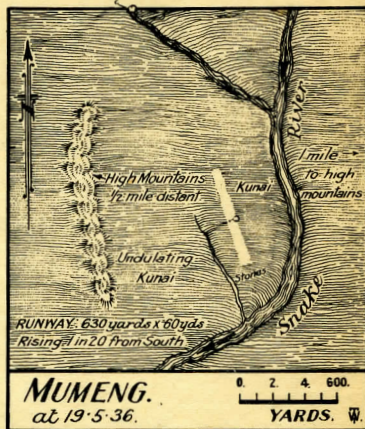
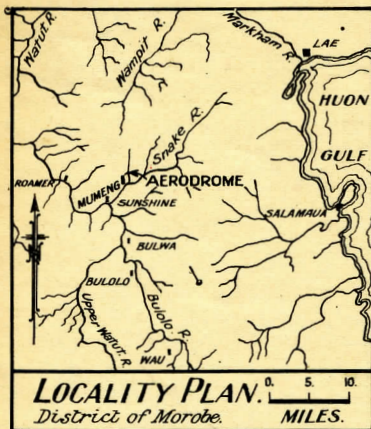

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome, licensed for single and light twin-engined types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: The Lutheran Mission Finschhafen Incorporated, Finschhafen, New Guinea.

POSITION: On the right bank of the Snake River, about 4 miles N.N.E. of Sunshine.
 Lat. 7° 01' S. Long. 146° 38' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 5½° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Snake River to the south and east; high mountains about 1 mile to east and about ½ mile to west.

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE &c.: Single strip, rising 1 in 20 from the south; good in all weather.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 630 yds. x 60 yds. wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 3,100 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Approach from the south only, up Snake Valley, then over scattered stones.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Mountainous.

PETROL AND OIL: Bulwa, about 7½ miles (by air) south.

WATER SUPPLY: River nearby.

WORKSHOPS: Bulwa.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Bulwa W/T "V.L.T."

NEAREST TOWNSHIP: Bulwa (about 15 miles by fair track).

REMARKS: Lutheran Mission Station about 1 mile west.
