

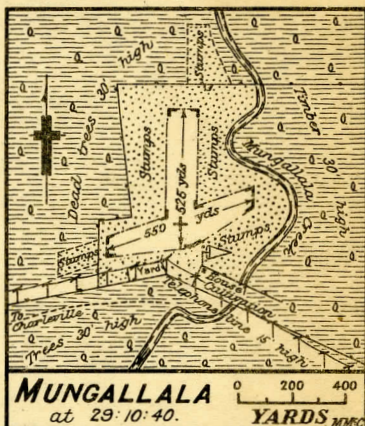
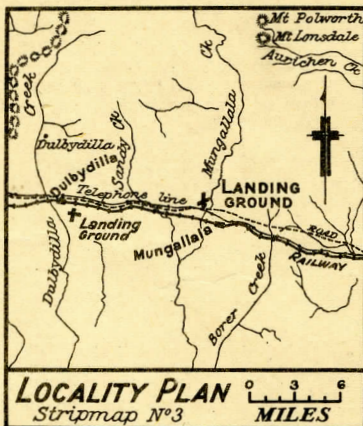

LATITUDE: 26° 26' S. LONGITUDE: 147° 32' E. MAG. VAR: 7½° E. app.  
ALTITUDE: 1,390 feet approx.

POSITION: Situated NW of Mungallala township on NW side of  
junction of Mungallala Creek and road.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet G.8. Stripmap No.3.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Clearing in timber. Tel. line on south.

APPROACHES: Over timber in all directions. Timber felled on  
all sides except south, where approach is over tel. line.

MARKINGS: White cross, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 525 yards; WSW-ENE, 550 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Mungallala, ½ mile SE.

TELEPHONE: Mungallala.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Mitchell, 18 miles E.

REFUELLING: Mungallala.

WATER: At house to south.
