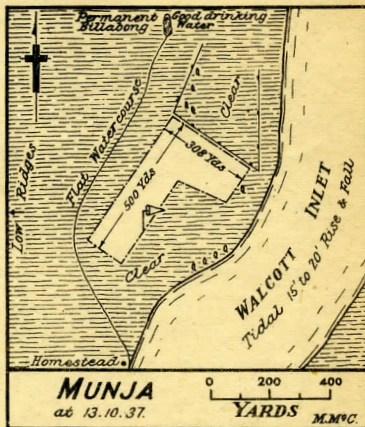

CLASS OF GROUND: Suitable for light types of landplane.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Native Affairs, Perth, W.A.

POSITION: On west coast of the head of Walcott Inlet.

Lat: $16^{\circ} 22' S$; Long: $124^{\circ} 56' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $2^{\circ} E$ approx.

LANDMARKS: Head of Walcott Inlet.

Homestead, 500 yards SW.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator and corner marks.

SURFACE: Sandy loam; suitable in all weather.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW: 500 yards; NW-SE: 308 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 10 feet.

APPROACHES: Trees within 60 ft. of boundaries felled.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Low ridges 300 yards from the western boundary. Walcott Inlet on east side. Flat country to the north and south.

PETROL, OIL & WORKSHOPS: No information available.

WATER SUPPLY: Permanent billabong 300 yards north of landing ground.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Radio at Homestead.

NEAREST TOWN & SEAPORT: Derby, about 120 miles SW.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
