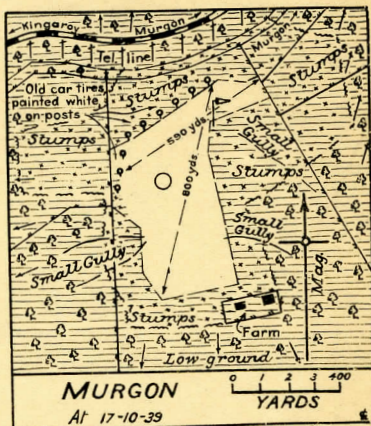
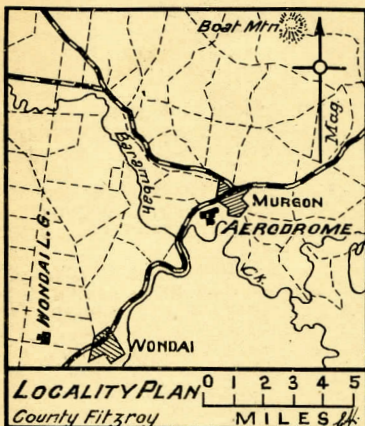


DATA SHEET FOR LANDING GROUND NO.287

(REVISED - APR. 1940)

MURGON, QLD.

LICENSED AERODROME - C CLASS



LATITUDE: 26° 15' S; LONGITUDE: 151° 56' E; MAG. VAR. 8° 30' E app.

ALTITUDE: 1,000 feet approx.

POSITION: 1 mile SW of Murgon Railway Station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet G.9.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating and timbered; unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Murgon township 1 mile NE, railway 300 yards north, and farm buildings immediately SE.

APPROACHES: N and E - over stumps and tel. lines. S - over stumps and farm buildings. E - over stumps, timber and gullies.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator. Boundary marks, consisting of old car tires hung on posts, along N and NW boundaries.

DIMENSIONS: NNE-SSW, 800 yards. NE-SW. 590 yards.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN, RAILWAY STATION and TELEPHONE: Murgon, 1 mile NE.

HANGAR: Nil.

REPAIRS and REFUELLING: Murgon.

WATER: At farm to SE.

PROPRIETORS: Murgon Shire Council, Murgon, Qld.

CHARGES: 2 persons (including pilot) 2/6 per landing, 10/- p.d.

3 or 4 " " " 5/- " " 15/- "

5 or 6 " " " 7/6 " " 25/- "

Over 6 " " " 10/- " " 40/- "

SPECIAL REMARKS: This aerodrome should be suitable in all weather.
