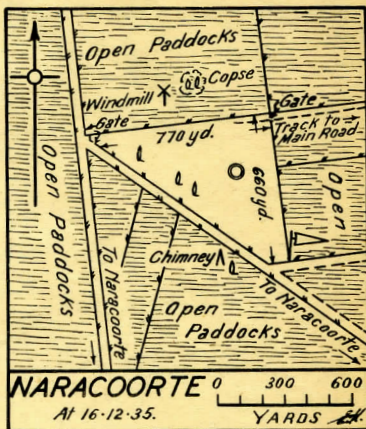
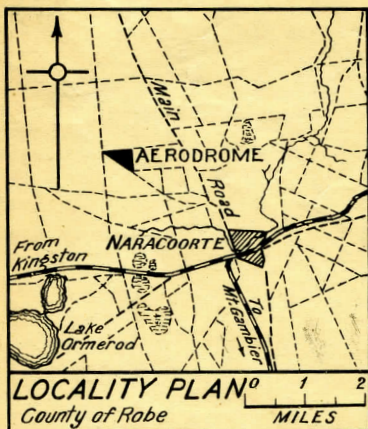

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single and light multi-engined landplanes.

PROPRIETOR: Mrs. M.H. Malone, Naracoorte, S.A.

POSITION: $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles N.W. of Naracoorte.

Lat. $36^{\circ} 56'$ S. Long. $140^{\circ} 41\frac{1}{2}'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Triangular ground with road junction at western apex.

Main Naracoorte-Border Town road (bitumen), 1 mile east.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Level, grassed surface, slightly rough, with 3 standing trees as shown on plan above.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 660 yards. E. - W. 770 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 180 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: North, windmill 25 ft. high and small copse; south, old chimney; east and west, open. Ground is fenced on all sides.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Level grassy plains suitable for forced landings. Low timbered ridge east of Naracoorte-Border Town main road.

PETROL AND OIL: Naracoorte.

WATER SUPPLY: Well at windmill near northern boundary.

WORKSHOPS: Naracoorte.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: Naracoorte.

TELEGRAPH: Naracoorte.

NEAREST TOWN: Naracoorte, about 3 miles by road.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Naracoorte.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
