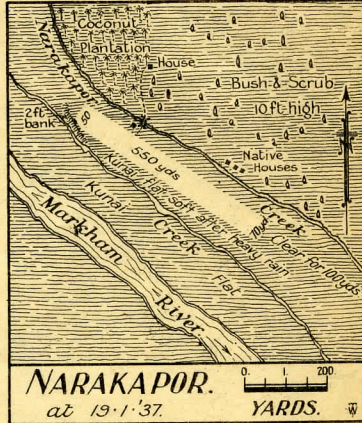
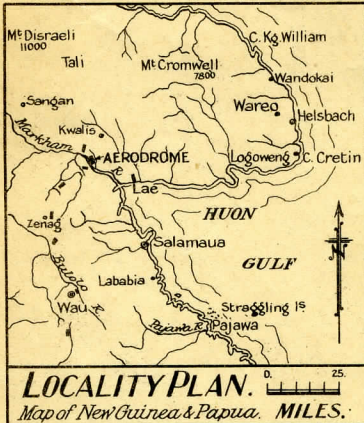


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NARAKAPOR, N.G.

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome, suitable for single and light multi-engined landplanes.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. A. Lorraine, Lae, New Guinea.

POSITION: On the left bank of the Markham River, about 10 miles from the mouth. Lat.: $6^{\circ} 41\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long.: $146^{\circ} 51'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Markham River to the South, coconut plantation and house to North.

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE: Good level well grassed surface.

DIMENSIONS: Single strip 550 yards NW-SE by 70 yards wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 20 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: From N.W. clear; S.E. clear for 100 yards, then over low scrub.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered to the North, otherwise river flats.

PETROL AND OIL: Lae, about 17 miles S.E. by track.

WATER SUPPLY: Creeks nearby.

WORKSHOPS: Lae.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Lae.

NEAREST TOWN: Lae.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: A good level strip, suitable in all weather.
