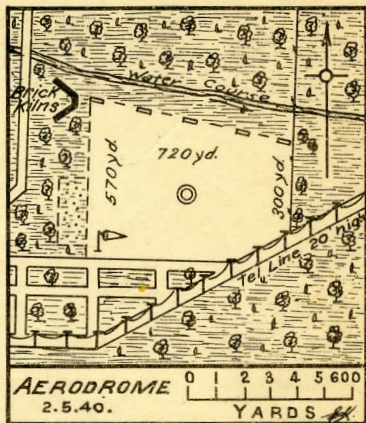
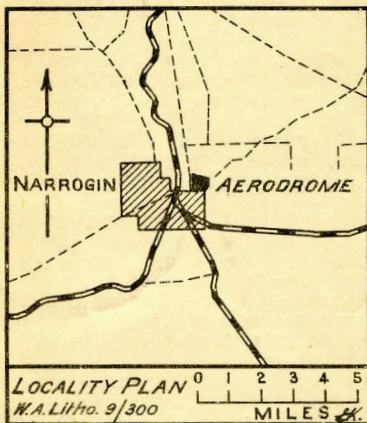

LATITUDE: $32^{\circ} 53\frac{1}{2}'$ S; LONGITUDE: $117^{\circ} 14'$ E; MAG. VAR. $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West.

ALTITUDE: 1,180 feet approx.

POSITION: At NE corner of town and north of main Wickepin Road.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet J.3.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Cultivated and undulating. Forced landings may possibly be made.

LANDMARKS: Old brick kilns near NW corner.

APPROACHES: North - over scrub to north of water course.

South - scattered trees and scrub, and telephone line. East - open generally, but some trees and telephone line. West - scattered trees with gaps.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, west side 570 yds, east side 300 yds. E-W, 720 yds.

SURFACE: Slightly rough and liable to grow suckers.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Narrogin, 1 mile SW.

TELEPHONE: Narrogin.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING & REPAIRS: Narrogin.

WATER: Water laid on to ground.

PROPRIETORS: Municipality of Narrogin, W.A.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Ground liable to be soft after rain.
