

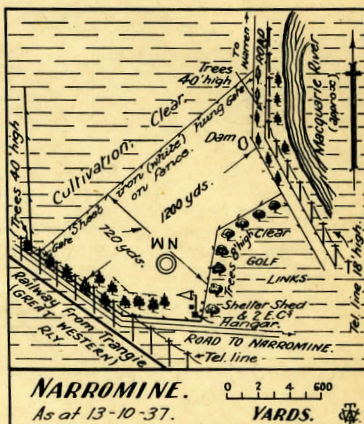

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.
 PROPRIETOR: T.E.Perry, Esq., Narramine Station, Narramine, N.S.W.
 POSITION: One mile NW of Narramine Railway Station on NE side of Dubbo-Nyngan Railway. Lat: 32° 13' S; Long: 148° 14' E.
 MAGNETIC VARIATION: 8° E approx.
 LANDMARKS: Railway line and Macquarie River.
 MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator.
 Letters NM north of white circle.
 SURFACE: Good red loam surface.
 DIMENSIONS: NE-SW: 1,200 yards; NW-SE: 720 yards.
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 780 ft. approx.
 APPROACHES: N and NW - clear; NE and SW - trees 40 ft. and tel. lines; SE - trees about 16 ft. high.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open paddocks with belts of timber. Generally suitable for forced landings.
 PETROL & OIL: On aerodrome, at Aero Club hangar (agents).
 WATER SUPPLY: At dam on aerodrome.
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: One hangar, 60' span by 40' depth.
 TELEPHONE: On aerodrome (Narramine No. 204).
 TELEGRAPH: Narramine P.O.
 NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Narramine, 1 mile SE.
 CHARGES: For overnight stay - 2/- to 10/- per night, according to size of aeroplanes. 25% discount for week or longer.
 REMARKS: Relative stripmap No. 60.
 Resident manager on aerodrome. Refreshments available.
