

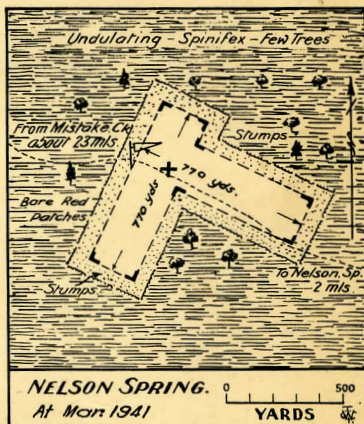
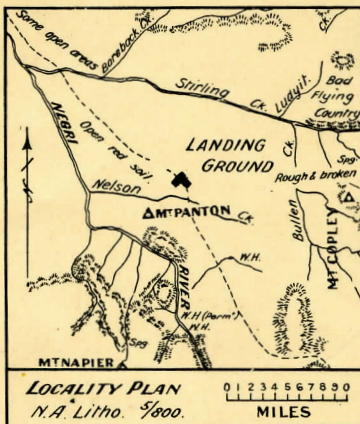

EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 17° 19' S. LONGITUDE: 129° 18' E.
ALTITUDE: 700 feet approx. MAG. VAR: 3° E. app.
AVIATION MAPS: Sheet E.5, Strips 1 and 56.
SURFACE: Hard reddish soil over limestone. May be slippery after rain, but should be safe in all weathers. SW end of NE-SW run is rough but not dangerous.

PROPRIETOR: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Nearest habitation at Mistake Creek Station, 21 miles north-west.
