

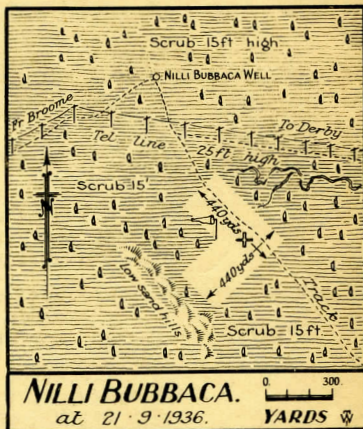
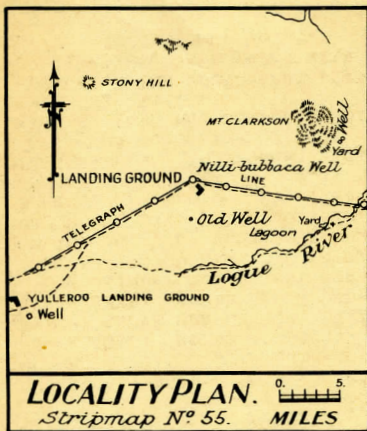

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
 PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.
 POSITION: Situated 6 chains South of tel. line and about 68 miles E.N.E. of Broome. Lat.:17° 38½' S. Long.: 123° 10' E.
 MAGNETIC VARIATION: 2° East approx.
 LANDMARKS: Tel. line, 6 chains, and Nilli Bubbaca well, ¼ mile, to the North.
 MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.
 SURFACE: Firm, grassed.
 DIMENSIONS: N.E.-S.W. 440 yards; N.W.-S.E. 440 yards.
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 75 feet approx.
 APPROACHES: From North over tel. line 25 feet high; otherwise over scrub 15 feet high.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scrubby.
 PETROL and OIL: Yeeda River Station, about 30 miles East.
 WATER SUPPLY: Nilli Bubbaca Well, ¼ mile North.
 WORKSHOPS: Blacksmith's shop at Yeeda River Station.
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
 TELEPHONE and TELEGRAPH: Tel. line could be tapped in emergency.
 NEAREST TOWN and SEAPORT: Broome, about 68 miles W.S.W.
 CHARGES: Nil.
 REMARKS: This ground should be used only in emergency. Ant-hills are liable to develop very quickly, and these may present dangerous obstacles.
