

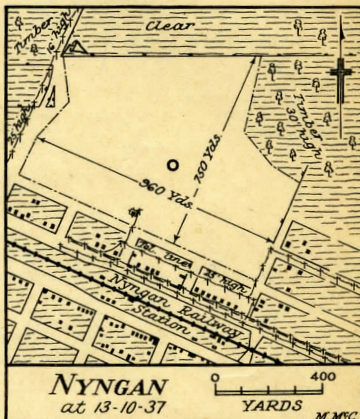
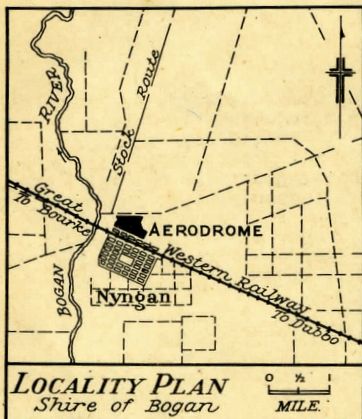

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for use by all types except large multi-engined landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.
POSITION: Situated immediately north of the Nyngan Railway Station. Lat: $31^{\circ} 33' S$; Long: $147^{\circ} 11\frac{1}{2}' E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: $7^{\circ} E$ approx.
LANDMARKS: Bogan River to west. Township adjoining on the south.
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
SURFACE: Good, hard and level.
DIMENSIONS: NE-SW: 750 yards; NW-SE: 960 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 570 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: North - open; south - H.T. lines 25 ft. high; east - timber up to 30 ft.; west - over tel. line 20 ft. high.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open and possible for landings.
PETROL, OIL & WORKSHOPS: Nyngan.
WATER SUPPLY: Houses adjoining.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Nyngan P.O.
NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Nyngan.
