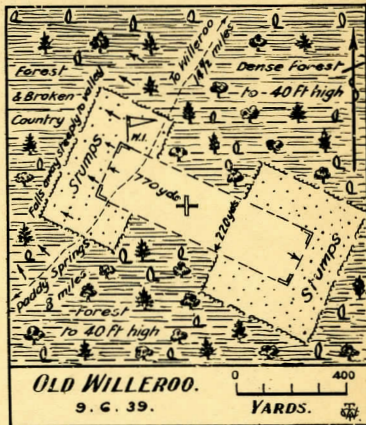
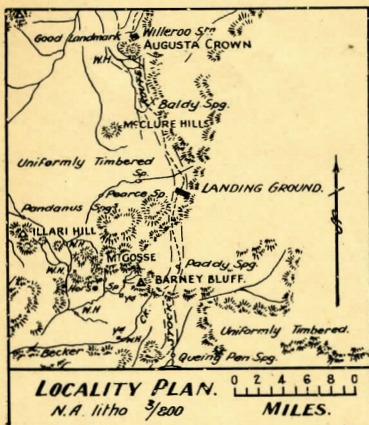

OLD WILLEROO, N.T.
EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 15° 28' S; LONGITUDE: 131° 38' E; MAG. VAR: 3½° E. app.
ALTITUDE: 700 feet approx.
POSITION: On Katherine-Wave Hill Road, 13 miles S. of Willeroo Station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet D.6, Stripmap No.1.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Heavy forest, up to 40 ft. high.

LANDMARKS: Main motor track runs through ground.

APPROACHES: Timber felled at each end. Ground falls away steeply on western side. Approach from western side quite open.

MARKINGS: White cross, wind indicator and corner marks.

DIMENSIONS: 770 yds. long by 220 yds. wide.

SURFACE: Red sandy soil, should be good in all weathers.

TOWN and RAILWAY STATION: Katherine, 95 miles N.E.

TELEPHONE: Manbulloo, 87 miles North-East. P.O. at Katherine.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING and REPAIRS: Katherine.

WATER: Old station, 2½ miles West in valley.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Department, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.
