<i>Class of Aerodrome</i> ..	All types of landplanes.	N.T.A./36
<i>Position</i> .. ..	Latitude, 21° 42 <sup>5</sup> S.; longitude, 115° 1' E. Situated 4½ miles south of Onslow.	86' #
<i>Distinctive Features</i> ..	Marsh on north and north-west and about ¼ mile east. Road and telegraph line on eastern boundary.	
<i>Markings</i> .. ..	Ground marking (circle) and wind indicator.	
<i>Description</i> .. ..	Sandy loam surface, flat and good in wet weather. Few limestone outcrops on the edge. <i>Surface soft in wet weather</i>	N.T.A. 1/36
<i>Dimensions for Landing</i>	North and south, <del>600</del> 660 yards. 660 East and west, <del>600</del> 800 yards. 800	
<i>Height above Sea Level</i>	5 feet.	
<i>Magnetic Variation</i> ..	1° 40' W. (approx.).	
<i>Approaches</i> .. ..	North, clear. South, sandhill 25 feet high about 80 yards distant. East, telegraph line about 80 yards distant. West, clear.	
<i>Surrounding Country</i> ..	Spinifex ridges unfit for forced landings, and marshes sometimes fit for forced landings.	
<i>Petrol and Oil</i> .. ..	At aerodrome (W.A. Airways Ltd.).	
<i>Water Supply</i> .. ..	Tanks at hangar.	
<i>Workshops</i> .. ..	Onslow.	
<i>Hangar Accommodation</i>	One hangar, 42 feet x 26 feet. (The property of W.A. Airways Ltd.).	
<i>Nearest Telephone</i> ..	At hangar.	
<i>Nearest Telegraph</i> ..	Onslow Post Office.	
<i>Nearest Town</i> .. ..	Onslow, 4½ miles.	
<i>Nearest Railway Station</i>	None in district (Onslow nearest port).	
<i>Charges</i> .. ..	Nil.	
<i>Remarks</i> .. ..	This ground replaces the former (see Notice to Airmen No. 14 of 1925), which will now be known as Onslow South.
