

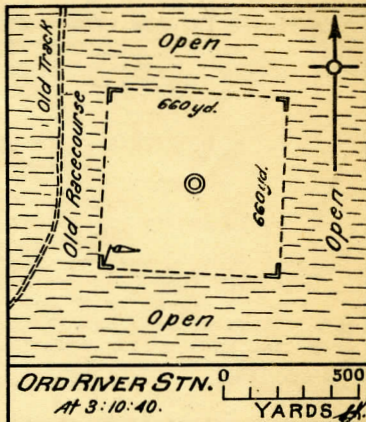
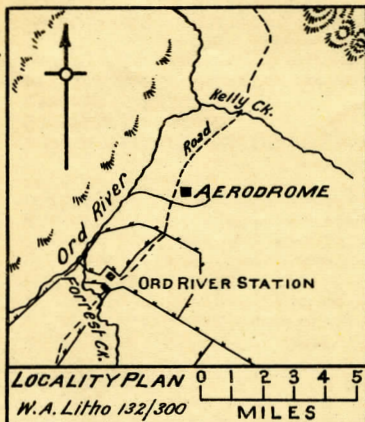

GOVERNMENT AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 17° 31' S; LONGITUDE: 128° 54' E; MAG. VAR: 3° E app.
ALTITUDE: 700 feet approx.

POSITION: 4½ miles NE of Ord River Homestead, and 2 miles E of Ord River.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.5. Stripmaps No. 1 and 56.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flats, intersected by timbered creeks.

LANDMARKS: Timbered creek south of aerodrome. Ord River 2 miles west.

APPROACHES: Open all around.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 660 yards. E-W, 660 yards.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN & SEAPORT: Wyndham, 220 miles by road.

TELEPHONE: Ord River Station, 4½ miles SW.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Blacksmith at Ord River Station.

REFUELLING: Ord River Station Homestead.

WATER: Ord River 2 miles west.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.

SPECIAL REMARKS: During and immediately after heavy rain pilots should use the area near the ground mark.
