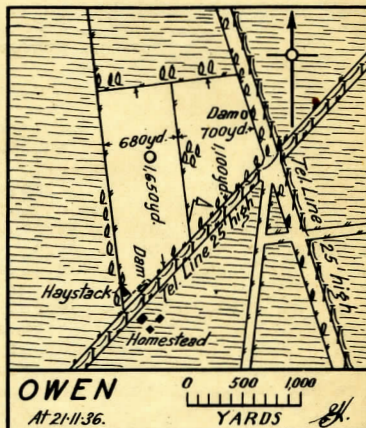
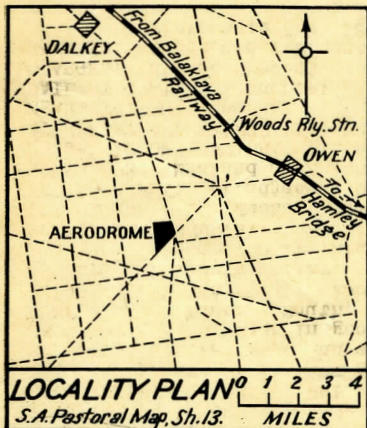


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

OWEN, S.A.

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. P. H. Laffer, The Pinery, Owen, S.A.

POSITION: 5 miles S.W. of Owen.

Lat: $34^{\circ} 17\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long: $138^{\circ} 28\frac{1}{2}'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 6° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Dam and clump of trees in S.W. corner.

Homestead on south side of road near S.W. corner.

MARKING: White circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Slightly undulating and grassy. Landing area is divided into two portions by wire fence.

DIMENSIONS: Eastern area, 1,100 yards by 700 yards.

Western area, 1,600 yards by 680 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 350 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: N., few scattered trees. E. and S.E., telephone line 25 ft. high and trees along road. W., trees along southern half of boundary.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Cleared, generally level and cultivated.

PETROL AND OIL: Homestead adjacent.

WATER SUPPLY: Homestead adjacent.

WORKSHOPS: Blacksmith's shop at homestead.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: At homestead. (Owen 51).

TELEGRAPH: Owen P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Owen, 5 miles N.E.

RAILWAY STATION: Owen.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

REMARKS: Relative strip maps, Nos. 16 and 36.
