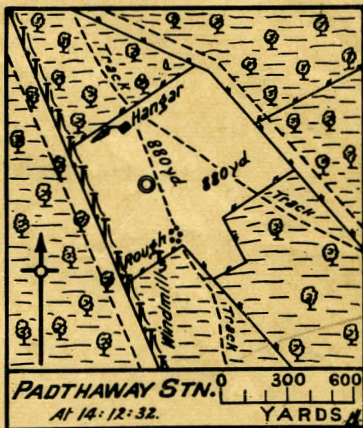
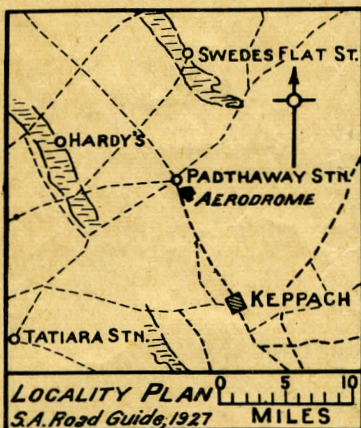

PADTHAWAY STATION, S.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETOR: A. Keith Lawson, Esq., Padthaway Station, Naracoorte, South Australia.
POSITION: About $\frac{1}{2}$ mile a little East of South of Padthaway Homestead.
 Lat. $36^{\circ} 36' 30''$ S. Long. $140^{\circ} 29' 30''$ E.
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Homestead buildings to North. Road and Telephone line on Western side. Windmill on Southern boundary.
MARKINGS: White circle.
DESCRIPTION: Well grassed, somewhat undulating, sloping down to North and East. Fenced all round and surrounded by timber.
DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 880 yards.
 N.E. - S.W. 880 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 100 feet approx.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: 6° E. approx.
APPROACHES: Timber about 50 feet high on all approaches except South, which is generally open with scattered trees.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally timbered with some open spaces to the South.
PETROL AND OIL: Limited supply at hangar.
WATER SUPPLY: Tank at hangar.
WORKSHOPS: Blacksmith's shop at Homestead. Garages at Naracoorte.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Hangar 35 feet (span) by 30 feet.
NEAREST TELEPHONE: Private line to Homestead from Lake Roy Station (Naracoorte 156).
NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Naracoorte, 30 miles S.S.E.
NEAREST TOWN: Naracoorte, 30 miles S.S.E.
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Naracoorte, 30 miles S.S.E.
CHARGES: Nil.
REMARKS: Pilots are advised that the ground towards the Northern corner falls rather steeply.
 Pilots should observe for stock which may be grazing on the Aerodrome. Relative Strip Map, No.42.
