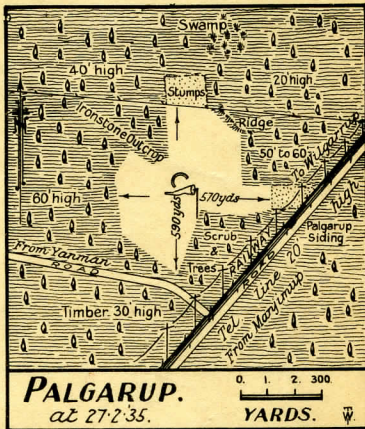
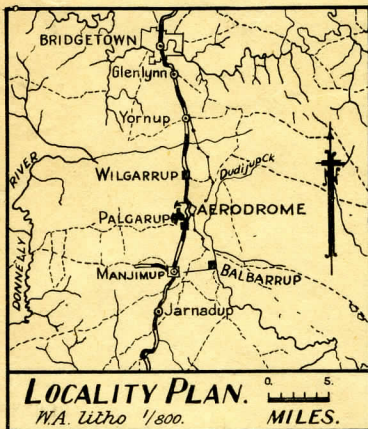

PALGARUP, W.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome, licensed for light types of land-planes only.

PROPRIETOR: M.C.A. Shaw, Esq. Manjimup, W.A.

POSITION: Immediately to west of railway line; adjoining Palgarup siding, and about 4 miles north of Manjimup.

Lat.  $34^{\circ}10\frac{1}{2}'S$ . Long.  $116^{\circ}9\frac{1}{2}'E$ .

MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ . approx.

LANDMARKS: Railway and Palgarup siding immediately to east.

MARKINGS: White semi-circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Level, grass covered surface.

DIMENSIONS: N.-S. 590 yards. E.-W. 570 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 826 ft.

APPROACHES: Timber all around, up to 60' high. Approaches felled N. and E. Railway & tel. line E. See plan.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hilly and heavily timbered.

PETROL AND OIL: At Manjimup, about 4 miles south.

WATER SUPPLY: Spring at S.W. corner of ground.

WORKSHOPS: Garages, Manjimup.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH AND TELEPHONE: Manjimup.

NEAREST TOWN: Manjimup.

RAILWAY STATION: Palgarup siding, immediately east of ground.

CHARGES: For each aeroplane : Landing - 2/6d.  
" " " Parking - 1/- per day.  
" " " Housing - 2/- " "
