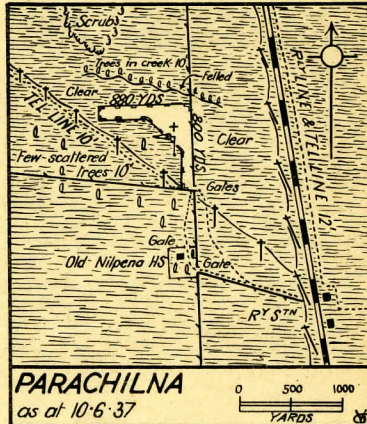
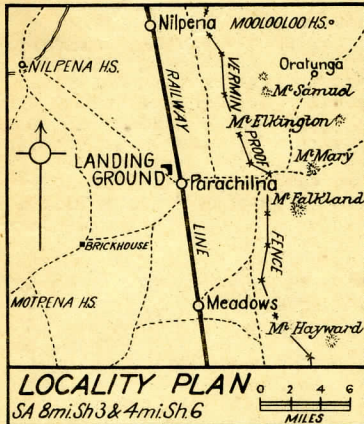


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

PARACHILNA. S.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.

POSITION: 1 mile N.W. of Parachilna Railway Siding.

Lat: $31^{\circ} 7' S$. Long: $138^{\circ} 23' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Railway line (Parachilna siding).

MARKINGS: White cross, boundary marks and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Smooth, with slight fall to east. Fenced on east side.

DIMENSIONS: North-South 800 yards; East-West 880 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 450 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: North - open country and tree lined creek;

South - old homestead and telephone line; East - railway and telephone line; West - telephone line, then open country.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough, scrubby and tree covered, intersected by creeks and wash-aways. Not suitable for forced landings.

PETROL & OIL: Small supply sometimes available in township.

WATER SUPPLY: Parachilna siding.

WORKSHOPS: Garage at Hawker, 57 miles south by rail.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Parachilna.

NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Parachilna.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: Stripmap No. 36.
