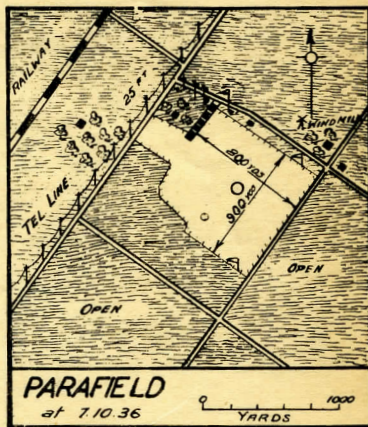
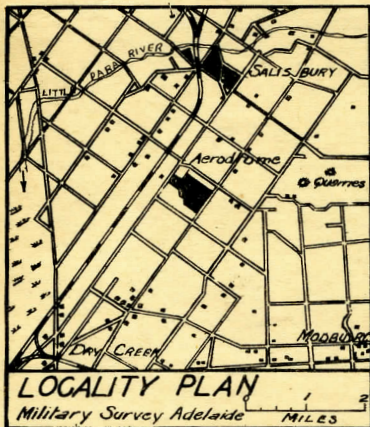

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.
POSITION: On W side of Gawler Road about 9 miles N of Adelaide.
Lat. $34^{\circ} 47\frac{1}{8}'$ S. Long. $138^{\circ} 38'E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: $6\frac{1}{8}$ E. approx.
LANDMARKS: Railway to West, and group of hangars.
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicators.
SURFACE: Good grassy surface, suitable in all weathers.
DIMENSIONS: N.E.-S.W. 900 yards. N.W.-S.E. 800 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 60 feet approx.
APPROACHES: West: Over telegraph wires 25 feet high; elsewhere generally open.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open, suitable for forced landing.
PETROL, OIL, & WORKSHOPS: On aerodrome.
WATER SUPPLY & ELECTRICITY: Aerodrome connected to city supply.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Several hangars, up to 90 feet span.
TELEPHONE: At Caretaker's office. Number: Salisbury 2.
TELEGRAPH: Salisbury P.O., 2 miles North.
NEAREST TOWN: Salisbury.
RAILWAY STATION: Parafield Siding, $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to West.
REMARKS: Hangar sites are available for leasing from the Civil Aviation Board. Strip map Nos. 5, 9, 16, 36, & 42.
