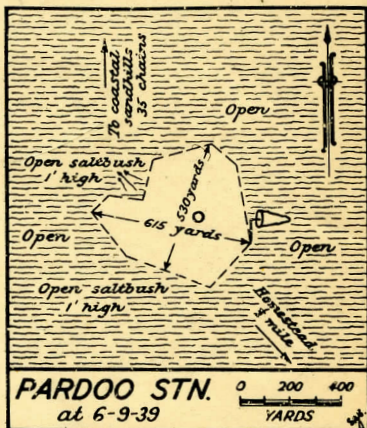
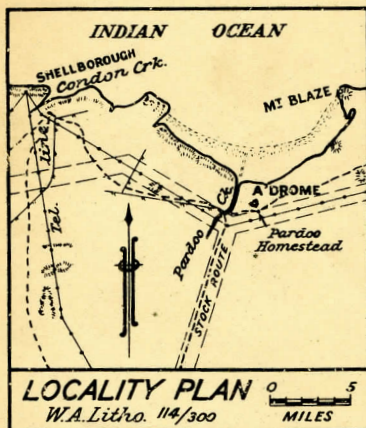

LATITUDE: 20° 61' S; LONGITUDE: 119° 34' E; MAG. VAR: 1° E.
ALTITUDE: 5 feet approx.
POSITION: About ½ mile North-West of Pardoo Homestead.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Sheet F.4, Stripmap No. 55.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open spinifex country and scattered scrub, suitable for forced landings.
LANDMARKS: Indian Ocean about 2 miles to North. Pardoo Creek 3 miles to West. Homestead ½ mile to South-East with white roofs.
APPROACHES: Coastal sandhills 50 ft. high 800 yds. to north. Otherwise over low saltbush.
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
DIMENSIONS: N-S, 550 yds; E-W, 615 yds.
SURFACE: Level red powdery clay salt marsh, boggy after rain.

TOWN: Port Hedland, 82 miles WSW or Marble Bar 80 miles S.
TELEPHONE: Pardoo Homestead.
HANGARS: Nil.
REPAIRS: Port Hedland 82 miles WSW.
REFUELLING: Limited supplies at Pardoo Homestead.
WATER: At Homestead.

PROPRIETORS: F.S. Thompson and Co., Pardoo Station, via Port Hedland, W.A.
CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: The ground is not available for use by aircraft in wet weather. The license is for dry weather only.
