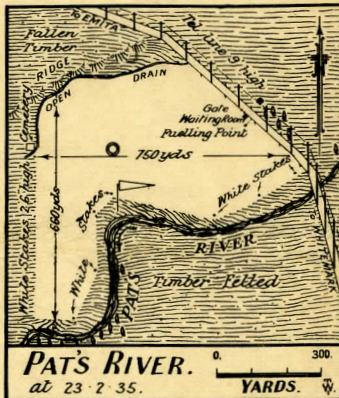
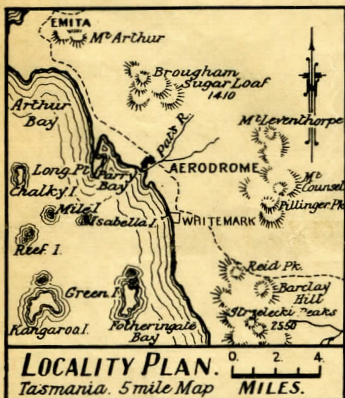


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

PAT'S RIVER, FLINDERS I., TAS.

(THESE CIRCULARS ARE FOLDED TO FACILITATE MAILING. TO SEPARATE, SLIT THE FOLD WITH A KNIFE).



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: Municipality of Flinders Island, Tas.

POSITION: Approx. 2 1/4 miles N.N.W. of Whitemark Jetty.

Lat. 40° 5' S. Long. 148° 0 1/2' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 9° E. approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Pat's River, along southern boundary, few graves at N.W. corner, Whitemark-Emita road along N.E. boundary.

MARKINGS: White Circle and Wind Indicator, white stakes at 40 yards interval along western boundary, and also few along river bank.

DESCRIPTION: Sandy soil with well grassed level surface.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 660 yards.

E. - W. 750 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 20 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Clear from seaward and south, some timber to eastward along river outside area; buildings, trees, fence and tel. line (9' high) on eastern boundary. Ditches along slope between road and cemetery to north.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open except for light scrub.

Range of hills to north. Mountain 2500 ft. 9 miles S.E.

High range 5 miles east. Open sea to west.

PETROL AND OIL: On aerodrome.

WATER SUPPLY: On aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: Whitemark. 3 miles by road.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: On aerodrome.

TELEGRAPH: Whitemark P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Whitemark.

NEAREST PORT: Whitemark.
