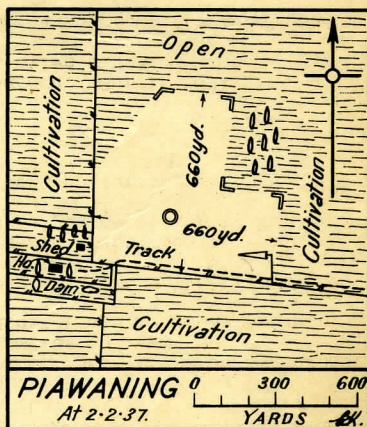
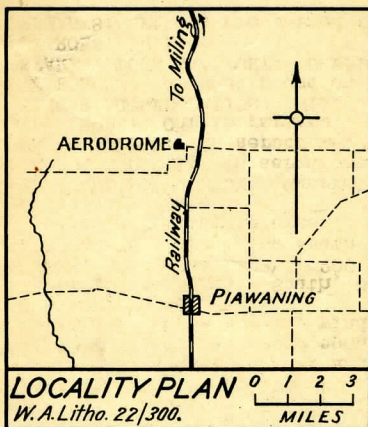


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome for all types of landplanes.
 PROPRIETOR: Mr. J.A. Rose, "Noonda", Piawaning, W.A.
 POSITION: 5 miles north of Piawaning and about 1 mile west of railway line.

Lat: $30^{\circ} 46'$ S. Long: $116^{\circ} 22\frac{1}{2}'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 4° W. approx.

LANDMARKS: Homestead near S.W. corner.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Good.

DIMENSIONS: North - South, 660 yards. East - West, 660 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 850 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Clear on all sides except for some trees 40 ft. high in N.E. angle of ground.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat cultivated land.

PETROL AND OIL: Piawaning, 5 miles south.

WATER SUPPLY: Homestead adjacent.

WORKSHOPS: Piawaning garages.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELMGRAPH: Piawaning P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Piawaning.

RAILWAY STATION: Piawaning.
