

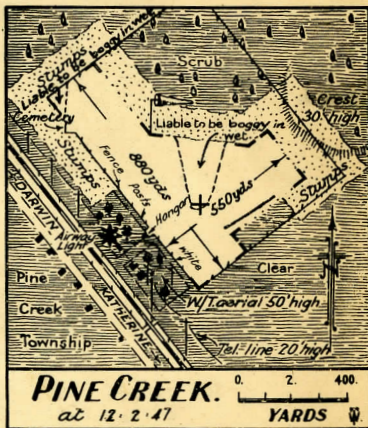
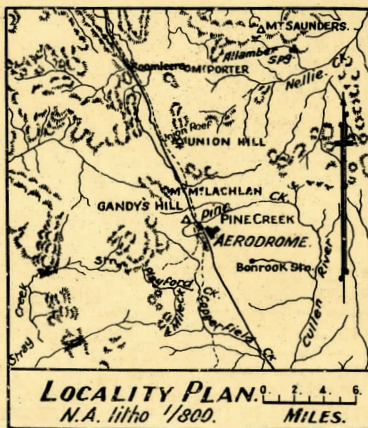

LATITUDE:  $13^{\circ} 49\frac{1}{2}'$  S. LONGITUDE:  $131^{\circ} 59'$  E.  
ALTITUDE: 620 feet approx. MAG. VAR:  $3^{\circ}$  E. app.  
AVIATION MAPS: Sheet D.6, Strip 7.  
SURFACE: Yellow gravelly loam. Generally good in dry weather, but patches are liable to be boggy in wet season (see sketch).

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots requiring information before visiting Pine Creek should telegraph the local Constable.
