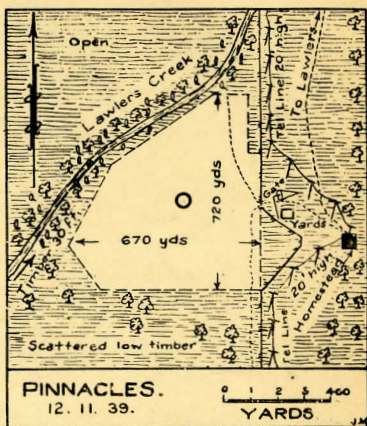
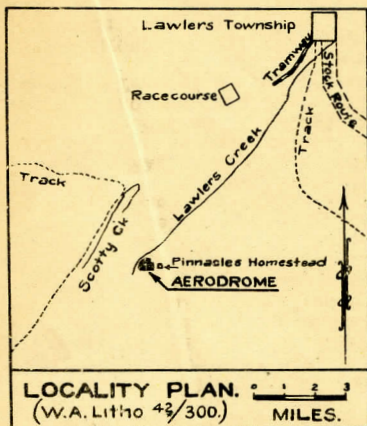

LICENSED AERODROME - B CLASS



LATITUDE: $28^{\circ}11\frac{1}{2}'$ S; LONGITUDE: $120^{\circ}25\frac{1}{2}'$ E; MAG. VAR. $0^{\circ}40'$ West.
ALTITUDE: 1,400 feet approx.

POSITION: 9 miles SW of Lawlers Township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet H-4.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scattered timber. Open patches exist where forced landings could possibly be made. Look out should be kept for rabbit burrows.

LANDMARKS: Lawlers Creek skirts west boundary. Homestead with red roof is situated on the east side.

APPROACHES: Trees to 30 ft. high along creek. Tel. line 20 ft. high along east side. Scattered trees to south.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 720 yards. E-W, 670 yards.

SURFACE: Generally in good condition. Level grassed land, red sandy loam. Rabbit burrows are likely to occur.

TOWN: Lawlers, 9 miles NE.

RAILWAY STATION: Leonora, 76 miles SE.

TELEPHONE: At Homestead (Lawlers No.1).

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Limited resources at Homestead.

REFUELLING: Limited supply at Homestead.

WATER: Homestead adjacent.

PROPRIETORS: Pinnacles Pty. Ltd., Leonora, via Kalgoorlie, W.A.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Liable to be boggy after rain. Rabbit burrows are likely to occur. Pilots are requested to advise the Manager, beforehand, of their intention to land on the aerodrome.
