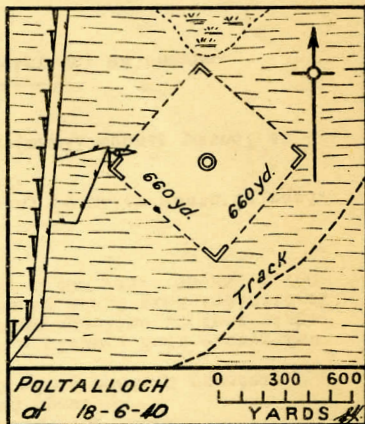

LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 35° 28' S. LONGITUDE: 139° 25' E. MAG. VAR: 6° E. app.  
ALTITUDE: 50 feet approx.

POSITION: On eastern side of main Melbourne-Adelaide road between Wellington and Meningle, 18 miles south of Taillem Bend.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Stripmaps Nos. 5 and 42. Mercator Sheet K.Z.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open grazing country suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Lake Alexandrina, 1 mile to the west. Telephone line along road to the west.

APPROACHES: Telephone line, 20 ft. high, along road to the west, otherwise clear.

MARKINGS: White circle, boundary marks and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: 660 yards in all directions.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: Taillem Bend, 18 miles north.

RAILWAY STATION: Cocks Plains, 16 miles north.

TELEPHONE: Ashville P.O., 3½ miles south.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Poltalloch Station.

REFUELLING: Wellington, 11 miles north.

WATER: On aerodrome.

PROPRIETORS: Miss D.J. Bowman, Poltalloch Station, via Taillem Bend, S.A.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Ground probably heavy in wet weather.
