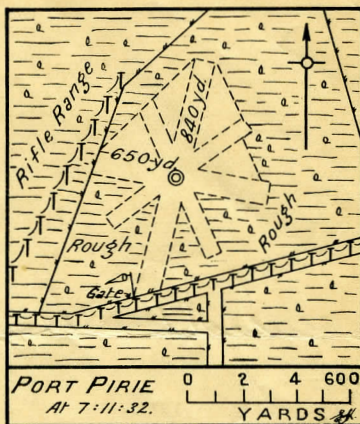
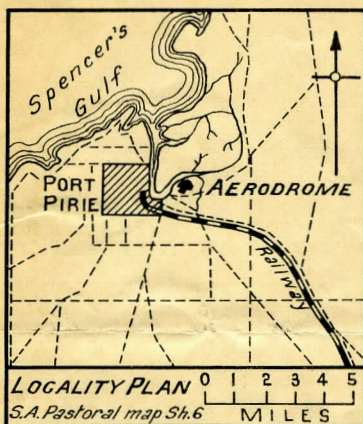


NOTICE TO AIRMEN.

PORT PIRIE, S.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of land-planes.

PROPRIETORS: Corporation of Port Pirie, S.A.

POSITION: About 2 miles east of Port Pirie on north side of St. Germein road.

Lat. $33^{\circ}11'S.$: Long. $138^{\circ}03'E.$

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Rifle Range on western side; creek to the north.

MARKINGS: White circle.

DESCRIPTION: Irregular shaped ground on saltbush and samphire flat. (see sketch).

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 840 yards.

E. - W. 650 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 50 ft.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $6^{\circ}E.$ approx.

APPROACHES. N. & E. - Low bushes.

S. - Telephone line 20 ft. high.

W. - Telephone line 14 ft. high.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough saltbush flats.

PETROL AND OIL: Port Pirie.

WATER SUPPLY: Sanitary Depot, south of aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: Port Pirie.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: Sanitary Depot.

NEAREST POST OFFICE: Port Pirie.

NEAREST TOWN: Port Pirie, 2 miles west.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Port Pirie, 2 miles west.

CHARGES: Under consideration.

REMARKS: Cinder runways should be used in wet weather.

Pilots should avoid flying low over the rifle range and to the north while firing is in progress.
