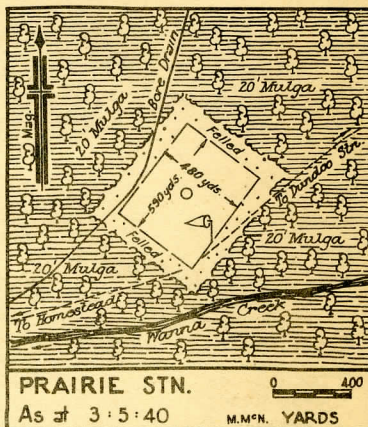
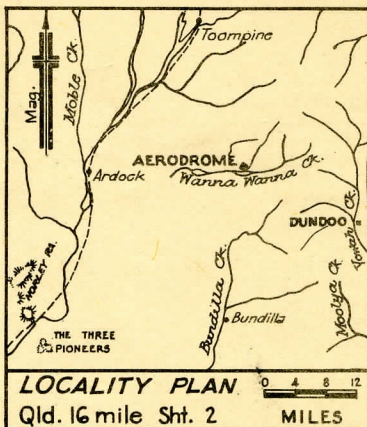

LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: 27° 31' S; LONGITUDE: 144° 23½' E; MAG. VAR: 6½° E app.
ALTITUDE: 680 feet approx.

POSITION: 65 miles SSE of Quilpie, and ½ mile NE of Prairie Station homestead.

RELATIVE AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.8.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Mostly timbered. Clear patches suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Prairie Station homestead, creek on south, The Sisters Hills 3 miles north.

APPROACHES: Low mulga scrub on all sides, felled to 100 yards from boundaries.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 590 yds. NW-SE, 480 yds.

SURFACE: Black ironstone gravel.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Quilpie, 65 miles NNW or Eulo 70 miles SE by road.

TELEPHONE: Dundoo, 7 miles. Transceiver at homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Limited supply and equipment at homestead.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETOR: R.S. Macnamara, Esq., Prairie Station, Qld.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
