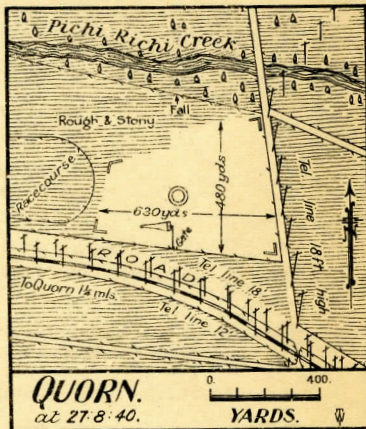
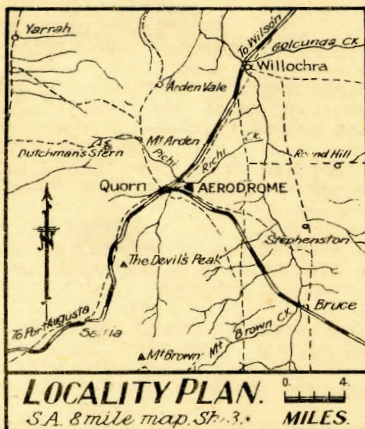

LATITUDE: 32° 20' S; LONGITUDE: 138° 03' E; MAG. VAR: 6° E. app.  
ALTITUDE: 900 feet approx.

POSITION: North of and adjoining the Quorn-Peterborough railway line 1½ miles east of Quorn.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: 2 Mercator Sheet. J.7. Stripmaps 36 and 51.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open, suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Quorn-Peterborough railway and road junction immediately SE, racecourse to W; Quorn 1½ miles W.

APPROACHES: North - over 30' trees in creek bed, otherwise clear. East - over road and 18' tel. line. South - over road, railway and two 18' tel. lines.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and corner marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 480 yards. E-W, 630 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Quorn, 1½ miles west.

TELEPHONE: Quorn.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Quorn.

WATER: On racecourse adjoining.
