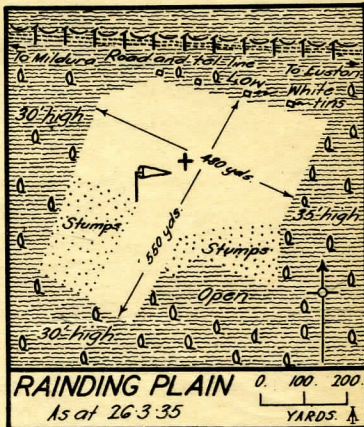
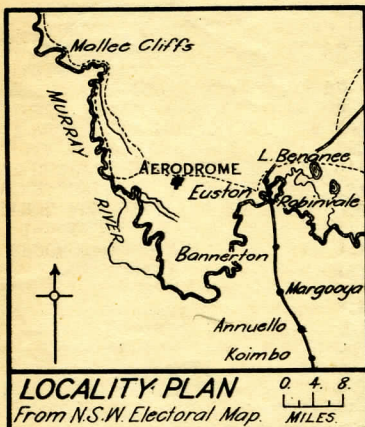


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

(CANCELS NO.17/1922) RAINING PLAIN, N.S.W.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.

PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne).

POSITION: Adjoins the South side of the Euston-Mildura Road, 11 miles from Euston and 33 miles from Mildura.

Lat.: 34° 33' S.; Long.: 142° 33' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 7° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Road and telegraph line on northern side.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Good.

DIMENSIONS: N.E.-S.W. 550 yards; N.W.-S.E. 480 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 185 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Over mallee 15 ft. high. Telegraph line on North side.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Dense mallee with some small clearings.

Unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: At Euston, about 11 miles east.

WATER SUPPLY: At dam, 1 mile South.

WORKSHOPS: Robinvale or Mildura.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: At Euston, about 11 miles East.

NEAREST TOWN: Euston.

RAILWAY STATION: Euston.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: Grass often very long on this ground.
