

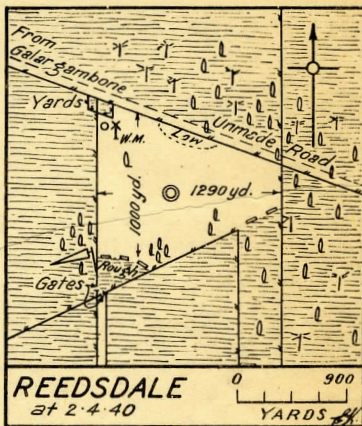

LICENSED AERODROME, "A" CLASS



LATITUDE: $31^{\circ}23\frac{1}{2}'$ S. LONGITUDE: $148^{\circ}41\frac{1}{2}'$ E. MAG. VAR: 8° E. app.
ALTITUDE: 750 feet approx.

POSITION: $14\frac{1}{2}$ miles ESE of Galargambone.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet J.9.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Belts of timber with grass and cultivation paddocks suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Sheep yards, windmill, and tank in NW corner; road and homestead about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile S.

APPROACHES: North and east - over scattered trees 40 ft. high; south and west - clear.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 1,000 yards; E-W, 1,290 yards.

SURFACE: Good, except for small heap of fibrolite in middle of white circle.

TOWN: Galargambone, 18 miles WNW by road.

RAILWAY STATION: Armature, 15 miles WSW by road.

TELEPHONE: At homestead, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile S. (34 Z. Tooraweenah).

REPAIRS: Galargambone.

REFUELLING: Limited supply at homestead.

WATER: Tank in NW corner of aerodrome.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. A.C. Milgate, "Reedsvale", Galargambone, N.S.W.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
