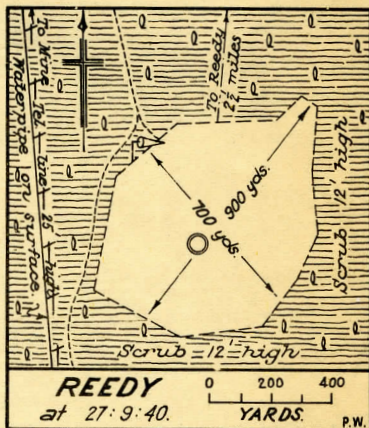
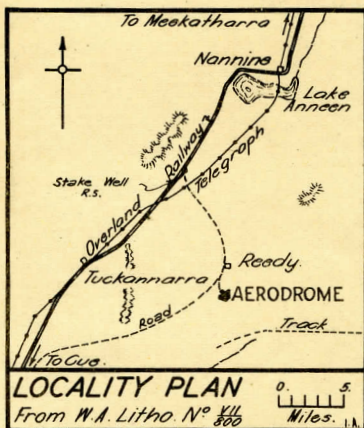

LATITUDE: 27° 09½' S; LONGITUDE: 118° 15½' E; MAG. VAR: 1° W app.  
 ALTITUDE: 1,500 feet approx.  
 POSITION: About 2½ miles S of Reedy.  
 RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet G.4.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough scrubby country, unsuitable for forced landings.  
 LANDMARKS: Large mine building ¾ mile N; Reedy township 2½ miles N; pipe and tel. lines to W.  
 APPROACHES: West - over 25 feet tel. line; north, south and east - over 12 feet scrub.  
 MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and corner markings.  
 DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 700 yards. NE-SW, 900 yards.  
 SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: Reedy, 2½ miles N.  
 RAILWAY STATION: Tuckanarra, about 12 miles WNW.  
 TELEPHONE: Triton mine, ¾ mile N.  
 HANGARS: Nil.  
 REPAIRS: Triton mine.  
 REFUELLING: Reedy.  
 WATER: Triton.

 CHARGES: Nil at present.
