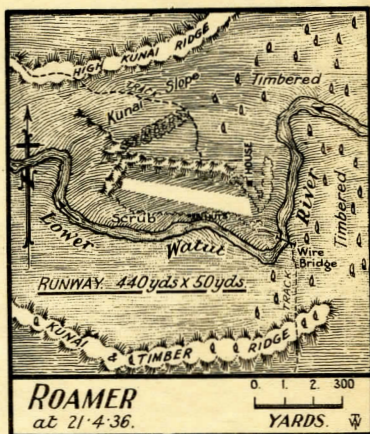
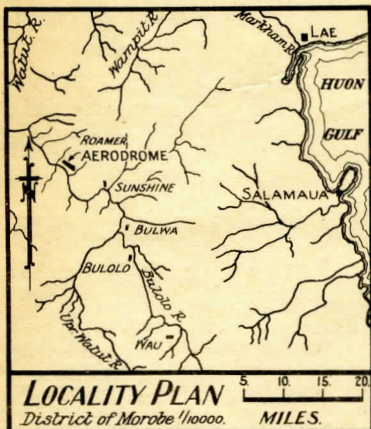

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for light types of landplanes only, under special conditions (see Remarks).

PROPRIETOR: L. Wilson, Roamer, via Wau, New Guinea.

POSITION: On right bank of Lower Watut River, between Sunshine and Marilinan.

Lat. $7^{\circ} 0\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long. $146^{\circ} 32'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Lower Watut River to south, east and west; ridge to north, and timbered ridge to south.

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE &c.: One-way cut grass strip; gradual fall to west.

DIMENSIONS: E. - W. 440 yds. x 50 yds. wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 1,000 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Ground to be approached from west only, over Lower Watut River and kunai ridges cleared of timber.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timber and kunai covered hills.

PETROL AND OIL: Bulwa, 17 miles (by air) south-east.

WATER SUPPLY: River nearby.

WORKSHOPS: Bulwa.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Bulwa w/t "V.L.T."

NEAREST TOWNSHIP: Bulwa.

REMARKS: Ground not to be used after 12 noon. Passengers may not be carried to or from the aerodrome except by pilots approved by District Superintendent. Loads out of the ground (passengers and/or cargo) may not exceed one-third of C.of A. normal commercial load.
