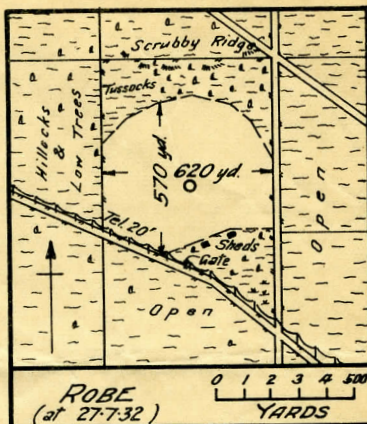
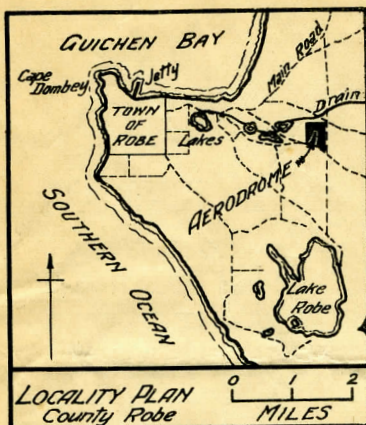


NOTICE TO AIRMEN.

ROBE, S.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single-engined land-planes.

PROPRIETORS: District Council of Robe, South Australia.

POSITION: About 3 miles east of Robe.

Lat. $37^{\circ}10'$ S. : Long. $139^{\circ}48'$ E.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Chain of small lakes to the west. Main road along S.W. boundary and Lake Robe about 2 miles south.

MARKINGS: Circle.

DESCRIPTION: Level grassed surface, somewhat tussocky.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 570 yds.

E. - W. 620 yds.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 20ft. approx.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 6° E.

APPROACHES: North - Low scrubby ridge.

South - 20' telephone line on road and scattered trees.

East - Clear.

West - Trees and low hillocks.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat scrubby and unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Robe.

WATER SUPPLY: Nil.

WORKSHOPS: Robe garages.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: Robe.

NEAREST TOWN: Robe, 3 miles west.
