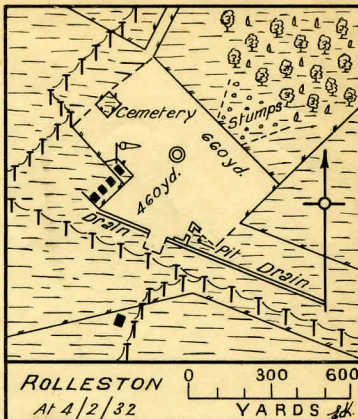
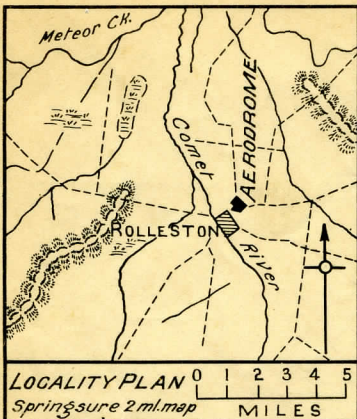


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO. 32/1932.
ROLLESTON, QLD.

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of single engined landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Trustees, Rolleston Recreation Reserve, Rolleston, Qld. (R.White, Esq. Hon. Sec.)

POSITION: Immediately North of Rolleston.

Lat. 24°28' S. Long. 148°38' E.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Cemetery on N.W. boundary. Buildings near S.W. boundary.

MARKINGS: White circle. Corner marks in S.E.

DESCRIPTION: Red soil ground falling towards the south and south-eastern boundaries. Probably soft after rain.

DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 660 yards.

N.E. - S.W. 460 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 900 feet. approx.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 7° E. approx.

APPROACHES: N.E. - Timber on high ground.

S.E. - Clear.

S.W. & N.W. - Telephone lines 25 ft. high.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, with open patches.

PETROL AND OIL: Rolleston.

WATER SUPPLY: Rolleston.

WORKSHOPS: Garage, Rolleston.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: Rolleston, P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Rolleston, immediately south of ground.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Springsure, 50 miles.

CHARGES: 2/6d. per landing.

REMARKS: Pilots should exercise care when landing towards the south as this ground falls somewhat steeply towards the drain on southern boundary.
