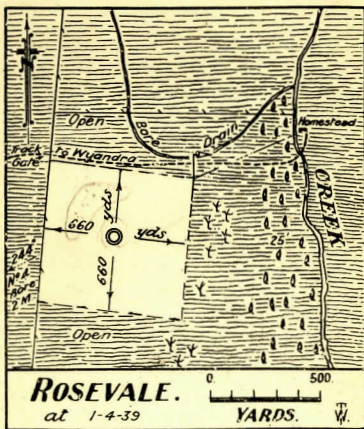
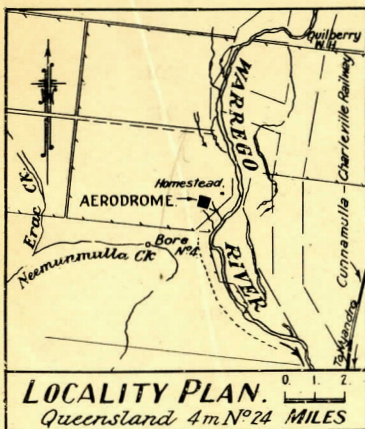

LICENSED AERODROME - B CLASS



LATITUDE: 27° 09' S; LONGITUDE: 145° 54' E; MAG. VAR: 7° E.
ALTITUDE: 850 feet approx.
POSITION: About 8 miles NNW of Wyandra and about ½ mile SW from Station Homestead.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet G.8, Stripmap No. 59.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Belts of timber with open spaces suitable for forced landings.
LANDMARKS: Homestead ½ mile to NE, Creek ½ mile E, and Bore drain to N. Charleville-Cunnamulla railway 6 miles E.
APPROACHES: Timber 25 ft. high, 200 yds. E, other approaches open.
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
DIMENSIONS: N-S, 660 yds; E-W, 660 yds.
SURFACE: Western portion slightly rough, balance good.

TOWN and RAILWAY STATION: Wyandra, 8 miles SSE.
TELEPHONE: Rosevale Homestead (Wyandra 24).
HANGAR: Nil.
REPAIRS: Charleville, 60 miles NNE.
REFUELLING: Limited supplies at Homestead.
WATER: At Homestead.

PROPRIETOR: Edward Hill, "Rosevale", Wyandra, Qlc.
CHARGES: Nil at present.

REMARKS: This ground is likely to be bad after rain, and intending users should telephone the Homestead for advice beforehand.
