

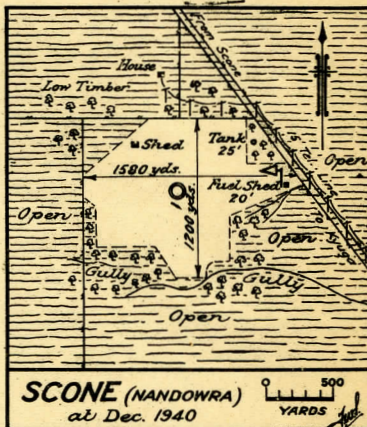

LICENSED AERODROME, "A" CLASS



LATITUDE:  $32^{\circ} 07\frac{1}{2}'$  S; LONGITUDE:  $150^{\circ} 50\frac{1}{2}'$  E; MAG. VAR:  $9^{\circ}$  E app.

ALTITUDE: About 700 feet.

POSITION: Approx. 6 miles SSW of Scone and  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile N of "Nandowra" homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.9. Stripmap No.49.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally suitable for forced landings. Hilly to the S-W.

LANDMARKS: Kyunga-Muswellbrook road immediately E.  
 Togar railway siding approx.  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles E.

APPROACHES: Tel. line to N and E. Elsewhere scattered trees with openings.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 1,200 yds. E-W, 1,580 yds.

SURFACE: Good surface, firm in all weathers.

TOWN: Scone, 6 miles NNE.

RAILWAY STATION: Togar railway siding, approx. 2 miles E.

TELEPHONE: At homestead  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile S (Scone 126).

HANGARS: Shed with 42 ft. opening.

REPAIRS: Scone.

REFUELLING AND WATER: On aerodrome.

PROPRIETORS: V.T. Hall, Esq., "Nandowra", Scone, N.S.W.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Neon identification lights at Scone (green), Murrundi, Muswellbrook, and Merriwa (red).
