

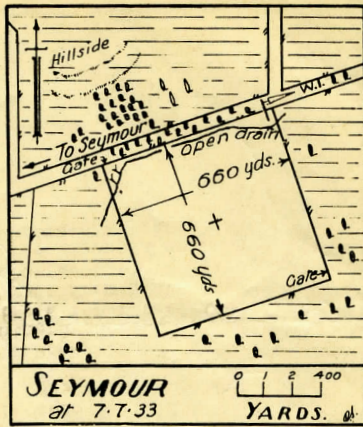
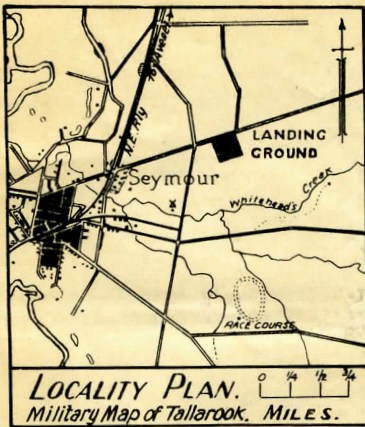

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia, (Royal Australian Air Force).
POSITION: Situated 2 miles East of Seymour.
Lat. 37°01'S; Long. 145°10'E.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: 8½° E. approx.
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Square ground, with drain along the northern boundary fence and trench close to West and South boundaries.
MARKINGS: Ground mark (white cross) and boundary marks.
Wind indicator at North-East corner.
DESCRIPTION: Surface good and smooth. Slight fall from the centre in all directions. Drains cut off small portion of North-West and North-East corners.
DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 660 yards.
E. - W. 660 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 464 feet.
APPROACHES: North, clump of trees and hillside; South, few scattered trees; East, few scattered trees; West, few scattered trees.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating with scattered trees. Surrounding paddocks have not been grubbed and have low stumps.
PETROL AND OIL: Seymour, 2 miles.
WATER SUPPLY: 2 creeks, ½ mile due South.
WORKSHOPS: At garages in Seymour, 2 miles South-West.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
NEAREST TELEPHONE: Ordnance stores, 1 mile South-West.
NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Seymour Post Office, 2 miles South-West.
NEAREST TOWN: Seymour, 2 miles South-West.
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Seymour, 1½ miles South-West.
CHARGES: Nil.
REMARKS: Thistles are likely to grow quickly in springtime.
