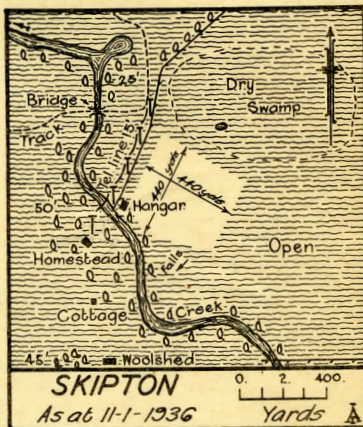


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO.95/1936.

("BANONGILL")

SKIPTON, VIC.



**CLASS OF GROUND:** Aerodrome suitable for use by light types of landplanes only.

**PROPRIETOR:** C.O. Fairbairn, Esq., "Banongill", Skipton, Vic.

**POSITION:** Situated 6 miles S.W. of Skipton on Mt. Emu Creek.  
Lat:  $37^{\circ} 41' S$ . Long:  $143^{\circ} 21' E$ .

**MAGNETIC VARIATION:**  $7\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ . approx.

**LANDMARKS:** Mt. Emu Creek to S.W., homestead, woolshed, etc., on opposite side of creek.

**MARKINGS:** Hangar and wind indicator.

**SURFACE:** Fair.

**DIMENSIONS:** N.W.-S.E. 440 yards. N.E.-S.W. 440 yards.

**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 900 ft. approx.

**APPROACHES:** North, South and East - clear. West - over tel. line 15 feet high and trees up to 50 feet.

**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Undulating with scattered trees. Suitable for forced landings.

**PETROL AND OIL:** At Skipton, 6 miles.

**WATER SUPPLY:** At homestead.

**WORKSHOPS:** At Skipton.

**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** For one "Moth", folded.

**TELEPHONE:** At homestead.

**TELEGRAPH:** At Skipton.

**NEAREST TOWN AND RAILWAY STATION:** Skipton.

**CHARGES:** Nil.

**REMARKS:** Tel. line on West is hard to see from the air. Cattle and sheep graze on aerodrome site.
