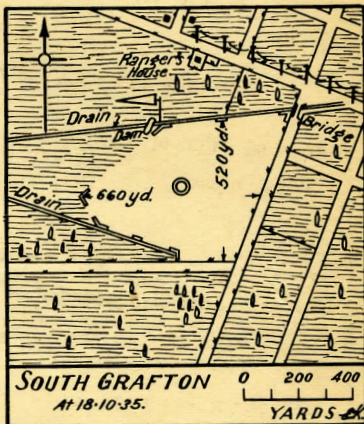
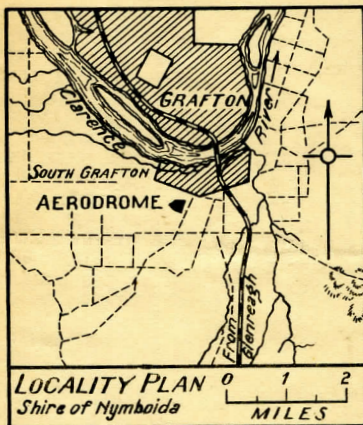

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all landplanes except large multi-engined types.
PROPRIETORS: South Grafton Municipal Council, Box No. 2, P.O., South Grafton, N.S.W.
POSITION: About 1 mile S.W. from South Grafton Railway Station. Lat. $29^{\circ} 43' S$. Long. $152^{\circ} 56' E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: $9^{\circ} E$. approx.
LANDMARKS: Town of South Grafton immediately N.E. Clarence River and town of Grafton about 1 mile north.
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
SURFACE: Good grassy surface.
DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 520 yards. E. - W. 660 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 30 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: North and east, scattered trees; south, small fir copse; west, clear.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open undulating patches suitable for forced landings.
PETROL AND OIL: South Grafton.
WATER SUPPLY: Houses adjacent.
WORKSHOPS: South Grafton.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEPHONE: South Grafton - No. 128.
TELEGRAPH: South Grafton P.O. $\frac{1}{4}$ mile N.E.
NEAREST TOWN: South Grafton.
RAILWAY STATION: South Grafton.
CHARGES: Nil at present.
