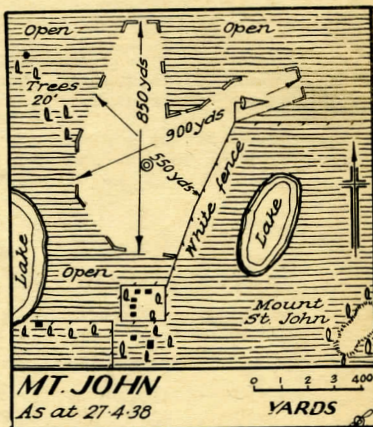
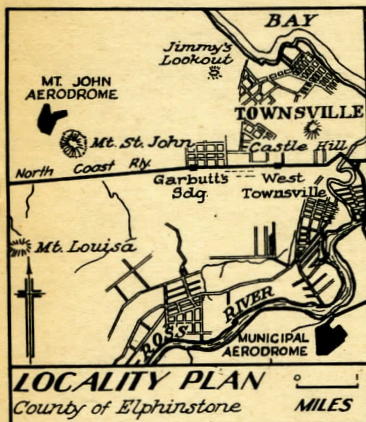


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

(TOWNSVILLE) MT. JOHN, QLD.



CLASS OF GROUND: Suitable for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETOR: St. John Robinson Esq., C/o Robinson Bros., Flinders Street West, Townsville, Qld.
POSITION: About 5 miles west of Townsville and Castle Hill.
 Lat: $19^{\circ} 15' S$; Long: $146^{\circ} 44' E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: About $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$.
LANDMARKS: Small lakes east and west of ground. Homestead and North Coast Railway to south.
MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.
SURFACE: Level and smooth; good in all weather.
DIMENSIONS: NE-SW: 900 yards; N-S: 850 yards; NW-SE: 550 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 15 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: North and east - clear; south - homestead and a few low trees; west - clear, except for some low trees.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open but hilly to south.
PETROL & OIL: Townsville, 5 miles east.
WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.
WORKSHOPS: Townsville Municipal Aerodrome.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEPHONE: At homestead (Townsville 902).
TELEGRAPH: Townsville (West End, $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles).
NEAREST TOWN: Townsville.
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Mt. St. John, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile (unstaffed).
