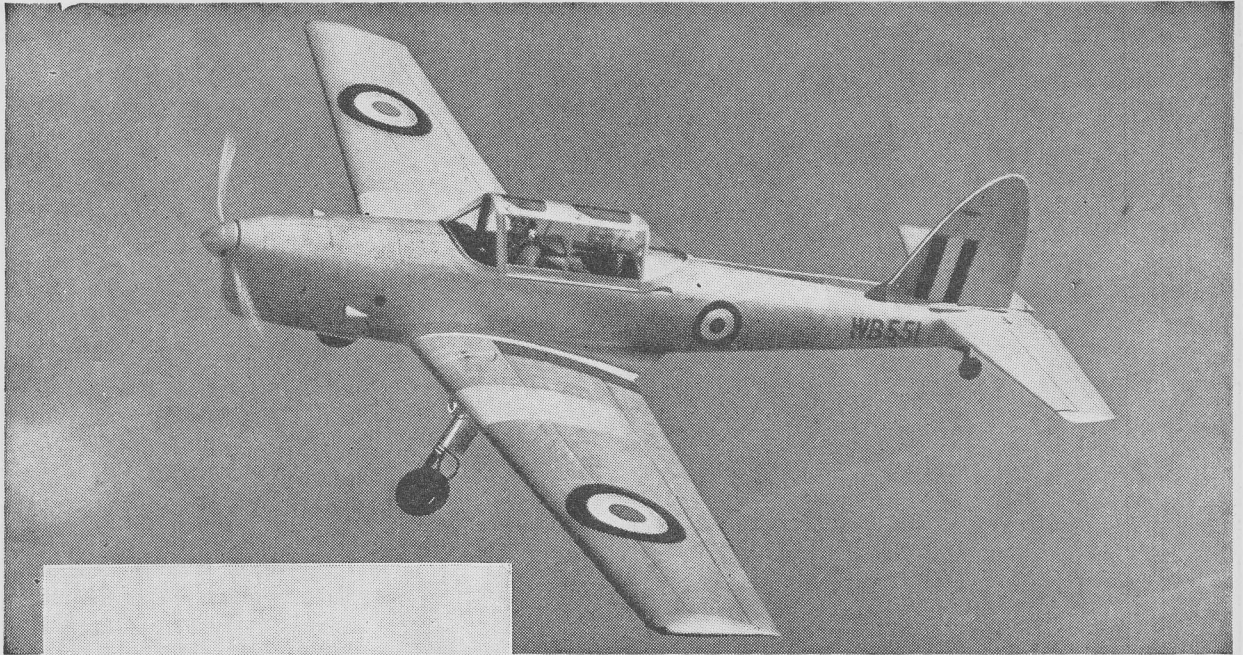


The de Havilland *CHIPMUNK*
