

Two Airmen Killed In Training Crash

MELBOURNE, Tuesday. — Two R.A.A.F. men were killed yesterday when a trainer plane crashed near Bairnsdale, Victoria.

They were:—

Pilot-Officer Alan George Grey, 24, single, of Thornbury, Victoria.

AC1 Denis Michael O'Loughlin, 19, single, of Northcote, Victoria.

The aircraft was seen to dive at a steep angle when flying at 2000 feet and failed to recover.

Pilot-Officer Grey was born at Albert Park and was a bank clerk when he enlisted in Melbourne in July, 1940.

AC1 O'Loughlin was a brass foundry employee when he joined the R.A.A.F. in April last.

At one time O'Loughlin was a promising apprentice jockey.
