

Bodies From 1942

Air Crash Found

An RAAF search party has located the wreckage of a Hudson plane which crashed near Cape Lore, on Timor Island, on September 24, 1942, and has found the bodies of the five members of the crew.

This advice has been received by Mr and Mrs T. J. Thomson, of Armentiers Street, Kedron, whose son, Flying Officer Gordon P. Thomson, was captain of the aircraft. Thomson previously had been reported missing. The Hudson was shot down by two Zero fighters when attacking Japanese installations on Timor.
