

### N.A.33 CRASHES.

#### Damage to be Repaired Locally.

CANBERRA, Thursday.  
The Minister for Defence, Mr. Street, revealed to-day that the N.A.33 aircraft brought to Australia as a prototype of the Australian-built Wirraway, and subsequently transferred to the Royal Australian Air Force, crashed recently, and was slightly damaged.  
To-day, authority was given to the Australian Aircraft Corporation to repair the machine, at a cost of £977.
