

PILOTS KILLED IN CRASH NEAR WINDSOR

Two officers were killed when a single-engined R.A.A.F. aircraft crashed at Sackville Reach, near Windsor, yesterday. They were:—

Pilot-Officer Terence Cathal Boyd McManus, 24, single, formerly of Semaphore, South Australia.

Pilot-Officer Peter Norris Ingoldby, 19, single, formerly of McLaren Vale, South Australia.

Central Area Headquarters stated to-day: "McManus and Ingoldby were engaged in blind flying practice, one being under a hood. The aircraft was seen to bank steeply to the right at a low altitude, hit telephone wires, and crashed."

McManus, whose father is a lieutenant-commander, R.A.N., was educated at Penrith High School and Cranbrook School.

Ingoldby was educated at Scots College, Adelaide, and Roseworthy Agricultural College (S.A.).
