

## 2 Planes Crash; One Dies

**MELBOURNE, Saturday.**  
Two aircraft crashes, one in NSW and one in Victoria, were reported by RAAF headquarters today.

Pilot Officer James Malcolm Wishart, 29, single, of Berri, South Australia, was killed, and LAC Warren Reay Knight, 19, single, of Unley, South Australia, was injured, when a trainer plane crashed at a service flying school in NSW yesterday.

The cause of the crash is obscure. Wishart and Knight were bank clerks before enlistment, and were both educated at St. Peter's College, Adelaide.

Two pilot trainees escaped injury in the second crash, in which an RAAF aircraft from a Victorian training school turned over and caught fire as it was taking off.

## ONE R.A.A.F. MAN KILLED IN CRASH

MELBOURNE, Saturday.—A pilot-officer was killed and an air trainee was dangerously injured when an R.A.A.F. trainer plane crashed at a service flying training school in N.S.W. on Friday.

The victims were Pilot-Officer James Malcolm Wishart (29), single, of Berri, S.A., and Leading Aircraftman Warren Reay Knight (19), single, of Unley, S.A.

Both were South Australians, both were bank clerks before enlisting, and both were educated at St. Peter's College, Adelaide.

The cause of the crash is obscure. Extensive damage was done to the aircraft.

Wishart was a leading Australian football player, having been placed three times for the annual competition medal.
